



Key Person

Every child will be allocated a Key Person and will belong to a little key worker group when they start Nursery. These groups meet every day to talk, have conversations together, plan the children's play, as well as little focused games and activities that help develop children's learning.

At the beginning of each session, we ask parents to support children in hanging up their coat and collecting their name-tag to give to their key person and say hello. The first 10 minutes of the session are a chance for parents to pass on information and have a brief chat with their key person, before saying goodbye to their child. The key person role is crucial in developing positive relationships with all our families and place high value in giving time to everyone, as fairly as possible.
