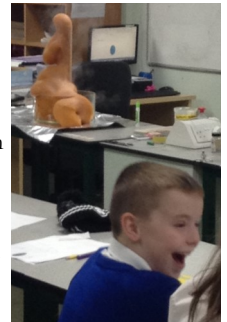


Connor in Y4 said, "I can't wait until it is our turn in Y4"
