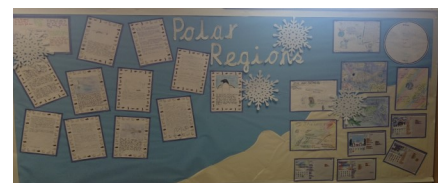
Year 1 Tagtiv8
