Dear Parents/Carers.



We are always looking for ways to make learning and information easier to access for you and your child which is why moving forward we will be using more QR codes in school and on letters/homework etc. You will see a Quick Response Code (QR code) example at the top right hand corner of this letter which will take you to our school website.

QR Codes can be viewed from any smartphone, tablet or laptop/chrome book (with a webcam). Some phones, like iPhone, automatically read a QR code in camera mode. If your device does not automatically do this, to view these codes you will first need to download the proper program or app. Any free QR Code reader will work but a few good ones are: QR Reader for iPhone, QR Code Reader by Scan, and Quick Scan-QR Code Reader. Once the app is downloaded to your mobile device you can immediately scan the QR Code. Make sure you allow access to the camera when prompted. When you scan it you may be asked to click either 'Open URL' or 'View Scan Data.' Click on the 'Open URL' and it will take you directly to the video/link/website.

If you are planning on using a laptop or chrome book you can use the website <https://www.the-qrcodegenerator.com/> to view the QR Code. Once at this site click on the 'Scan' tab to the left of the page and, when prompted, click allow access to your webcam. This will allow you to use your webcam to scan the code. Hold the code in front of the webcam and it will take you to the video.
