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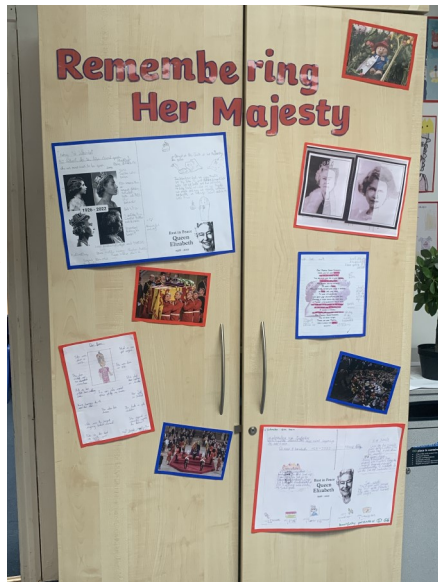
Nursery

Our Heritage

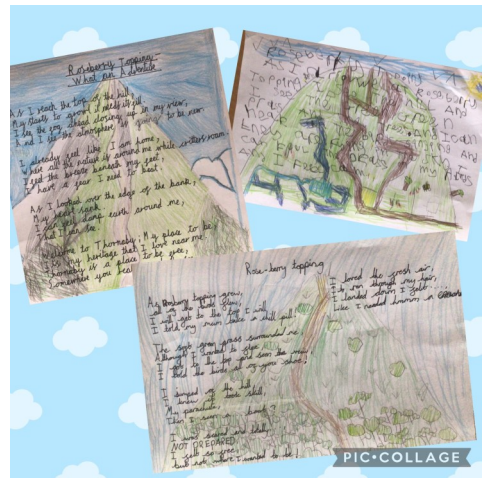
Year 5 have been looking at Roseberry Topping and using their senses to describe this wonderful place in poetry!
