## Dear Parents/Carers,

The school gates open at 8:45 and I would highly recommend children arriving then going into class at this time. If the children arrive after 8:45am and before 9am, they are not late, but could maximise learning time on offer by arriving earlier. Ten or fifteen minutes per day does not sound much, but over a week, month and year it will make a significant difference. We are finding that *children arriving earlier are making rapid progress* and want all children to benefit from this. Children arriving after 9am, even at 9:05am are missing twenty minutes education per day, which is one hour and forty minutes over the week. This will make a difference in any year group.

Parents Meetings by phone and in person have been happening across school over the past week and continue tonight. If you have missed the chance to see your child's teacher, please do not worry. Feel free to catch the class teacher and they can arrange a phone call or a face to face meeting so that you know how your child's education is progressing.
