'I like the moral of the story - Don't judge people on where they come from.' Mason

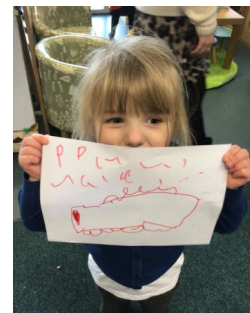
