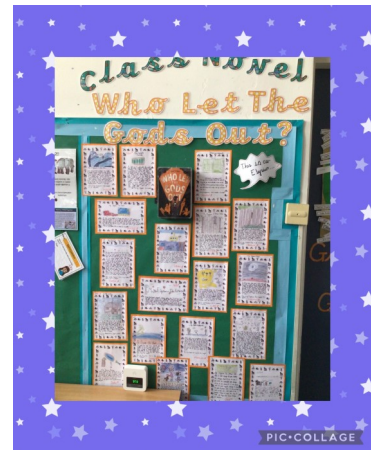
'My Elysium is in a car and driving through California with money in my hands.' Ava
