In Nursery, we are discriminating between the 't' and 's' sound by sorting shopping.

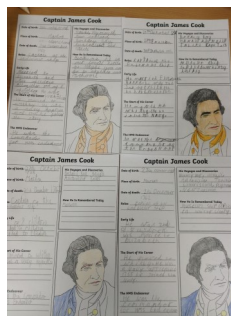


Year 5 - Hancock Museum
