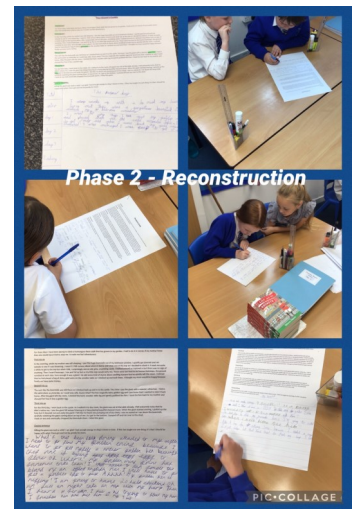

## Year 4

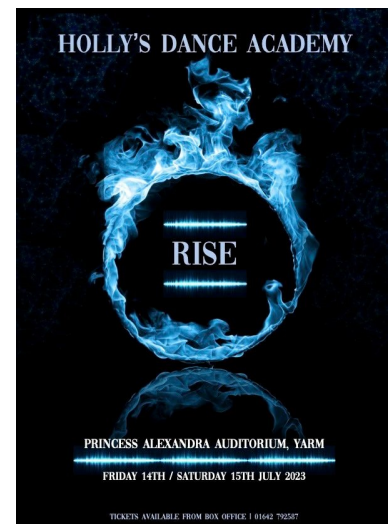
