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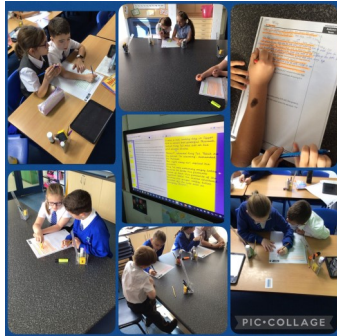


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This Year 5 child has completed her reading passport at home. Well done
