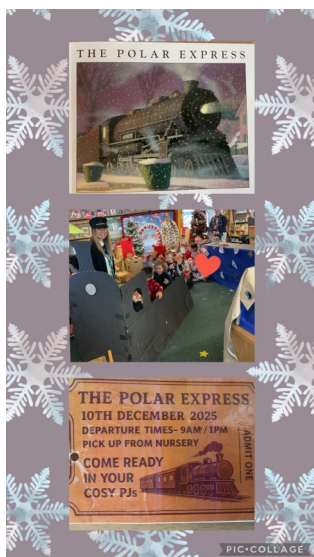
Thank you to all our families for contributing to this wonderful experience—and for sending the children in their cosy pyjamas. It made the day extra special!

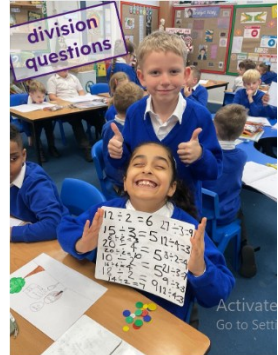
